Introduction

Create playful 3D blocks that you could almost grab. Use solids, blenders, or small scale prints in light, medium and dark shades from the same color family to make each lively block. Three fat quarters will make nine blocks. My sample is Baby Size but the pattern from Jaybird Quilts has instructions for Baby, Lap, Twin, or King. All you need is the Super Sidekick Ruler or a Template.

Fabrics Needed

For the Baby quilt you will need 4 light fat quarters, 4 medium fat quarters, and 4 dark fat quarter (one each from the same color family). For a Lap, increase the colors to 6, for twin, increase to 12, and for a king, increase to 22.

Fabric for the binding ranges from $\frac{3}{4}$ yard to $1 \frac{1}{8}$ yard depending on the size you choose to do.

Backing ranges from $2 \frac{1}{2}$ yards to $9 \frac{1}{8}$ yards

Batting ranges from baby to king size.

Supplies

Arcade Game pattern by Jaybird Quilts

Super Sidekick Ruler (it can be done with the Sidekick Ruler, but I found it awkward with the larger diamonds.)

Or you can use a template, in which case you will need one piece of template plastic 8"x 10" to make the templates from this pattern.

Pre-Class Preparation

If you are comfortable with the Jaybird Rulers you can cut out your diamonds and triangles. If not we can do that in class.
